### Bridge Update – Kinsey and Bret

Kinsey and Bret have been assisting the contractor with the north bridge project. Kinsey has been assigned as Art's designee in communicating information about the project to Skagit Trail Builders.

A temporary bridge has been constructed to move material across the creek. One concrete footer has been poured, the other is partially poured. Art is utilizing only 2-3 helpers per work session. Bret is assisting him by reaching out to a small group of STB volunteers who expressed interest. Most work sessions are in the evening during the week, 3pm-dark. Bret is emailing volunteers 1-2 days prior to invite to a work session.
