

Planning Meeting for March 22, 2025 Work Party (Dinner Count)

1. Review of March 8 work party
 - a. Did we achieve our work party objectives?
 - b. How did things go, in general?
 - c. Improvements & ideas

2. What is our plan for March 22?
 - a. We will be working at Song Sparrow Bridge and will have 2 guest groups: HKP Architects and Kids n' K9s 4H, so need to consider work that kids 8-13 can perform.
 - b. Objectives
 - i. Reinforce rock cages with 1-man, 4x8 and gravel. Then naturalize with organic material.
 1. Rock cages are already bending under the weight of the rock fill. Driving power carriers over them is going to increase the load. So, reinforcing is essential first step.
 - ii. Rock sand capping from west side of Hill Creek Trail to Connector Trail
 - iii. Decommission Borrow Pit 2 (near Big Rock)*

iv. Remove organic material from flagged trail to prepare for rock fill
